KEY FINDINGS

- The introduction of NIOS curriculum, special education classes, and scribe assistance enabled him to perform well in exams and gain academic confidence.

THE CHALLENGE

Ravi faced difficulties in fundamental academic skills such as reading, writing, and mathematics. Initially placed in Grade 8, he required additional support to cope with the syllabus. The transition to NIOS presented challenges, including documentation processes, subject selection, and miscommunication about exam schedules. Additionally, securing a scribe for his exams proved to be a complex task due to government policies.

THE SOLUTION

- **Circle Time:**
Regular interactive sessions helped Ravi build social confidence and express himself more effectively. Discussions on life skills, academic goals, and self-motivation during these sessions reinforced his engagement in the learning process.
- **Application-Based Assignments:**
Assignments focused on real-life applications, such as time management, money calculations, and functional mathematics, which strengthened his understanding. Hands-on practice in subjects like Painting and Data Entry Operations provided an opportunity for experiential learning.
- **Positive Reinforcement from Teachers and Parents:**
Teachers provided continuous feedback and encouragement, celebrating small achievements to boost his morale. His mother played an essential role by attending classes with him, reinforcing learning at home, and actively supporting his academic journey.

THE RESULT

- **Academic Progress:**

Successfully cleared two NIOS board exams (Painting and English), scoring 81 in English and 48 in Painting.

- **Confidence and Independence:**

Developed self-confidence through structured learning, personal contact programs, and practical exams.

- **Future Readiness:**

Demonstrated commitment and resilience, paving the way for further success in upcoming board exams
